



2022-2023 HIGH SCHOOL ELECTIVES*

MONDAY/WEDNESDAY ELECTIVES

AGRICULTURE (36 weeks/ 1 credit)

The purpose of this course is the cultivation of animals, plants, fungi, and other life forms for food, fiber, biofuel, medicine and other products used to sustain and enhance human life.

HIGH SCHOOL ART (36 weeks / 1 credit)

This is a two-semester course. First semester will consist of drawing with pencil, charcoal, colored pencils, pen & ink, etc. Second semester focuses on painting with mixed mediums (oil, watercolors, acrylics etc). These methods will be applied to multiple substrates including wood, glass, and fabric. Students will keep an art journal that will record their drawing progress, the application of color theory, art history, and art appreciation.

CHOIR/ENSEMBLE (36 weeks / 1 credit)

Hey, High Schoolers! You might need to get “tuned in” or “tuned up”. Come be a part of the Choir elective as we bust some tunes, create some moves, and beat to the rhythm of the drums. In the process, you’ll belong to a new “Saint family” and learn more about music than you might have thought possible. Find your voice and let others hear you! DRIVERS ED (18 weeks / ½ credit 1st or 2nd Semester)

A course of study for high-school students that teaches the techniques of driving a vehicle, along with basic vehicle maintenance, safety precautions, and traffic regulations and laws.

HEALTH (18 weeks / ½ credit 1st or 2nd Semester)

Health issues of vital concern to the well-being of the human body are covered in this course. The following topics are covered: general health and safety, physical fitness, nutrition, health hazards/life threatening diseases, mental and emotional health, and first aid and emergency health care.

HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUMENTAL (36 weeks / 1 credit)

Join Central Christian School high school instrument class for 9th - 12th grade. The class will be taught by Mr. Ben Reece who has over 20 years experience teaching a variety of instruments. Instruments offered this year are: Violin, Viola, Cello, String and Electric Bass Guitar, Flute, Piano, and Percussion. A **\$55 monthly fee** will be assessed per student. No prior instrument experience necessary.

TUESDAY/THURSDAY ELECTIVES

ACT TEST PREP (18 weeks / ½ credit 1st or 2nd Semester)

The ACT score that a student receives plays a large part in determining what college a student will be accepted to and whether or not he/she will receive a scholarship. Taking a prep course helps ensure your student will perform better and therefore increase his/her chances of getting a good score.

HIGH SCHOOL OUTREACH (36 weeks/ 1 credit)

Students in this class will meet for Bible study, mentorship, retreat planning, and service opportunities throughout the school year.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (36 weeks / 1 credit)

This course introduces concepts for personal development in health-related fitness and physical skills; these include cardiovascular exercise, body composition, strength, endurance, and flexibility. Students will develop physical and health-related fitness skills through participation in individual and field activities.

SHOP (36 weeks / 1 credit)

This course teaches an introduction to various mechanical skills including electric, carpentry, plumbing, auto mechanics, and home maintenance.

SPEECH/CREATIVE WRITING (36 weeks / 1 credit)

This course is in oral and written communication that includes developing and delivering various types of speeches, written prose and poetry, and learning various persuasive techniques. A foundation is laid for creating short stories and giving presentations to an audience. Emphasis is on the creative process.

YEARBOOK/JOURNALISM (36 weeks / 1 credit)

Students in the Yearbook/Newspaper class prepare and compile content for the yearbook and school newspaper. We will produce a monthly newsletter this year. We will create and publish the 2021/2022 yearbook this year. Students will use computer programs such as Adobe PhotoShop, Herff Jones Edesign, Lucidpress program and Excel to complete the tasks.
